Dr. Monica Vazirani is a professor at UC Davis. She received her PhD from UC Berkeley in 1999, after which she had an NSF Postdoctoral Fellowship and postdoctoral positions at UC San Diego, UC Berkeley, MSRI, and Caltech. Dr. Vazirani's research interests center on the representation theory of algebras related to the symmetric group and how to express algebraic phenomena via the combinatorics of partitions, tableaux, crystal graphs and parking functions.

From her involvement in the Noetherian Ring as a graduate student to her participation in this summer's IAS-WAM program, Dr. Vazirani is an enthusiastic organizer and participant in activities aimed at promoting women in mathematics.
